Y Care International is the YMCAs' global lead in youth enterprise and employment. Through partnerships with YMCAs and other community-based organisations, we equip some of the world's most disadvantaged young women and men to move into decent work and out of poverty. We aim to create 1 million opportunities for decent work by 2030.

We are looking for two volunteers to join our international programmes team to support us and our partner organisations to deliver high-impact programmes with young people in 15 countries in the global South. This is an excellent opportunity to gain valuable experience and skills that will help you to develop a career in the international development sector.

Volunteer candidates will be educated to degree level or equivalent and have excellent analytical, numerical, research and writing skills, with knowledge and interest in international development issues. A qualification (degree or other) in international development or a related subject, ability to work in French or Spanish, and some prior experience of working in the voluntary sector are desirable, but not essential.

The [Enterprise and Employability \(E&E\)](#) Volunteer will support YCI's Youth Employability Advisor who provides technical support to YCI and our network of southern civil society partners to strengthen the design, delivery and evaluation of our youth enterprise and employability programming. This includes identifying and collating learning and best practice to develop learning resources, 'how-to' guides and training materials in core thematic areas such as youth-friendly finance, life-skills and business mentoring.

The Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning (MEL) Volunteer will support the [MEL Unit](#) at YCI which focuses on measuring and evaluating the impact of YCI work using innovative methods that put young people at the centre of our approach. The purpose of our team is to generate and collate data and information that informs strategic decisions, thus improving our programmes in the future.

Volunteers will be based at our London office in Whitechapel (Zone 2), working alongside our International Programmes team and for 2 or 3 days a week for at least 3 months starting as soon as possible. Please note that we are not able to offer a salary for this position. However, Greater London travel (up to zone 6) and lunch expenses will be provided.
